At the Church Annual Parochial Church Council meeting on Monday 9th May, we will be due to elect people to the church council. To be nominated to stand for the PCC, or to vote in the elections, you must be on the church electoral roll, and you must not be legally disqualified from being a trustee of a UK charity.

There are various positions on the council which carry various responsibilities.

All PCC members

All PCC members are required to register as Trustees of the church during their period of service. This means ensuring compliance with charity and church law, prudence in use of church resources, and care in the way the church conducts its business and ministry. (CtK's general insurance policy includes a Church Council and Trustee indemnity section). The PCC generally meets monthly, except for December. The August meeting is for prayer and social time together. The meetings are usually on the 3rd Monday of the month. They alternate between joint meetings of PCC and Heads of Ministry (HoMs), followed by a short PCC meeting, and just PCC, when more substantial business is conducted. It is hoped that PCC members take an active interest in furthering the life of the church, and so a level of commitment beyond the monthly meetings is expected. It is also expected that members will be committed to praying for the church.

Church Wardens (2)

This is the senior lay leadership role, acting as advisor and sounding board to the Vicar, and carrying executive legal responsibilities on behalf of the PCC.

Two wardens will be elected to serve for one year.

Congregation representatives (11)

Anyone on the church's Electoral Roll may be nominated to serve on the PCC. It is good to have a range of people, from those who have been in the church a long time, to those who are newer, a mix of male & female, older and younger, from different congregations and involved in different aspects of the church's ministry. By convention at Christ the King, I I people are elected. The APCM may agree to increase or reduce this number, although the change cannot take effect until the following year.

Eleven Congregation representatives will be elected to serve for one year.
